



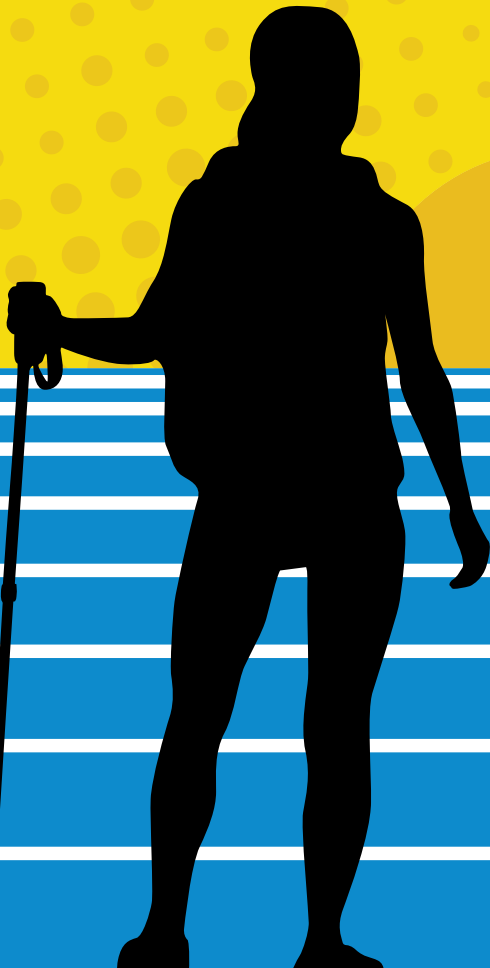

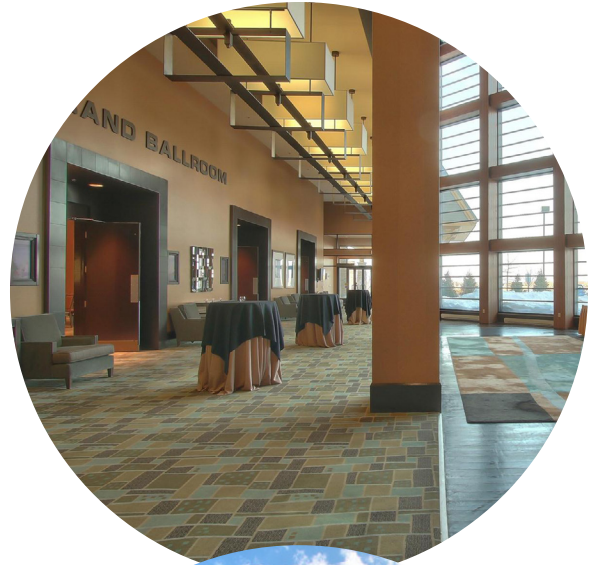
The conference show floor includes:

**Comedian, Auhtor, and Mental Health Advocate**

Jessica Holmes is one of Canada's top comedic talents. She has brought the house down opening for giants like Ellen DeGeneres, Russell Peters, Jerry Seinfeld, and Oprah Winfrey. She has also performed at Just For Laughs and The Second City, and starred in the hit comedy series, *Royal Canadian Air Farce* and *The Holmes Show*.

Her funny and inspiring book, *Depression The Comedy: A Tale of Perseverance*, takes readers deep into her mental health journey with validation and warmth. Jessica is grateful to help end the stigma around mental illness, and in 2018 was honoured to join the Bell Let's Talk team as a celebrity ambassador.

**Samra Zafar**  
**Leadership & DEI Expert, Author, and Physician-in-Training**

Samra Zafar is an award-winning, internationally renowned speaker, bestselling author, physician-in-training, and leading corporate consultant who specializes in diversity, equity, and inclusion; mental health and wellness; and authentic leadership.

A four-time TEDx speaker, Samra is currently pursuing a medical degree at McMaster's DeGroote School of Medicine, specializing in psychiatry. She has been recognized by Women's Executive Network as one of Canada's "Top 100 Most Powerful Women" and has been named among the "Top 25 Most Inspirational Women" in Canada and the "Top 25 Canadian Immigrants".

In 2019, Samra released her memoir, *A Good Wife: Escaping the Life I Never Chose*. It shares her journey of escaping an abusive child marriage to pursue her education and sheds light on gender-based oppression. She is currently writing her second book, titled *Unconditional*, which explores science-based strategies to unlearn limiting beliefs and live a fuller, unconditional life.

## Conference Charities

Each year, the AMCTO Board, staff, and conference planning committee select registered Ontario charities to support as part of an annual initiative to give back. In 2024, we are proud to support two regional charities – **My Friend's House** and **The Blue Mountain Watershed Trust Foundation (the Watershed Trust)**.



**My Friend's House** is a violence against women (VAW) crisis shelter serving women and children who have experienced abuse or who are at risk of experiencing abuse. The organization offers an eight-week program with the goal of finding women and children safe and affordable housing and connecting them with wrap-around services that support their needs as individuals or as a family.

**The Watershed Trust**, Ontario's first watershed trust, was formed in 1994 to protect natural areas in Collingwood and the Blue Mountains from development pressures of many kinds. Since then, the Foundation has been instrumental in preserving and protecting the region's remaining wild places.

AMCTO will be making a donation to each charity throughout 2024 and on behalf of our 2024 conference and Forum speakers. We also encourage all conference delegates to take some time to talk to representatives from each charity at the event to learn more about what they do and how you can help support in making a difference.


